FEES	£4 for BOF members with own SportIdent dibber. £5 for non-BOF members and/or those wishing to hire a SportIdent dibber.
COURSES	Long course (just under 4km / 125m climb). Short course (2km / 70m climb). The courses are suitable for Juniors and beginners.
CLOTHING	Suitable for standard training shoes, T-shirt and shorts (if not sensitive to long grass).
