<b>Directions</b>	<p>Assembly is at the reservoir just off Radnor Road GR TQ 095437, GPS 51.182231,-0.434521 but all vehicles (except traders) must enter via Hurtwood Control Car Park No 1 at <b>GR TQ 098431, GPS 51.177118,-0.430087</b>. Nearest postcode is GU6 7NT but that is on the wrong road. Easiest approach is from the North via Peaslake village (postcode GU5 9RW) bearing left up Radnor Road. Linear parking on sandy forest rides. Maximum walk to assembly 900 metres.</p> <p>Start is 250 metres from assembly. Finish is 50 metres from assembly.</p>

<b>Terrain</b>	An area of mature, moderately hilly woodland, with a mixture of re-entrants, spurs, gullies, depressions and providing a variety of route choice and some fine navigation challenges. Runnability is affected by the high bracken growth this summer, but courses have been planned to avoid the worst of this.

<b>Punching</b>	SPORTident punching. All controls and the finish will be in “beacon” mode for SIAC use.
<b>Starts</b>	10.30 to 12.30. Registration from 10.00 There will be a short gap in the start times around 11 a.m for Remembrance Sunday. Courses close at 1500 and we are happy to allow some late starters <a href="#">by arrangement</a> for those who are involved in Remembrance Sunday events. Enter as normal but let us know when you think you’ll be able to start. Start times will be published and should be adhered to as far as possible. A punching start will be used.
<b>Facilities</b>	Registration, download, bag storage and toilets at Assembly. Tom’s Catering and Ultrasport will be in attendance.
<b>Dogs</b>	Dogs are allowed in the area, although you are likely to meet members of the public walking their dogs.
<b>Prizes</b>	Medals for the first three in each of the classes. Prizegiving as soon as possible after 2.30 p.m. Please stay for it if you can.
