#### The nearest station is Hampstead Heath Overground Station.

Exit station, turn left and head south down South End Road. After 100m turn right up Pond Street. The pub is 150m on the right, opposite the Hospital.

#### The nearest Tube is Belsize Park on the Northern Line.

Exit tube, turn right and head north-west up Haverstock Hill. After 450m turn right down Pond Street. The Pub is 150m on the left, opposite the Hospital.

#### The Course

A one hour score course, with control sites worth between 10 and 50 points.

#### Equipment

You are advised to bring a torch and compass, as well as a pen to mark your answers. The traffic can be heavy in the area so hi-viz or light coloured clothing for extra visibility is strongly advised. We hope to use electronic timing, so bring your own dibber if you have one.

#### Fees

LOK/SLOW members £3, others £4. Juniors (16 and under) are not allowed to run street events unless accompanied by an adult.
