

LONDON O.K. INAUGURAL EVENT

DATE 23rd May, 1971

VENUE Great & Little Bookham Commons. O.S. Grid Ref 1707557130

TRAVELLING By road Approach by A246, and turn north into Rectory Lane just west of Great Bookham. Signs to carpark (1½ miles); please park tidily
By rail Registration is 200m east of Bookham S.R. station
By bus London Transport 418 bus serves Kingston, Surbiton, Epsom, Leatherhead terminating at Bookham Station.

TERRAIN Gently undulating ^{open} Surrey woodland. (It is hoped that by May the ground will be dry and yet brambles will be at an early stage of development - leg protection advised however). The very nature of the land dictates that 'elite' orienteers will not be tested by the course.

LAND The National Trust have kindly made the land available to us. Other people will be on the commons while we are there - please avoid causing them any annoyance, or disturbing wildlife

Do not enter Out-of-Bounds areas, or cross boundaries that are marked as 'uncrossable' on the map except at shown crossing-points

Courses A* 8½K (by shortest poss route) Senior men & better Senior women
B* 6½K (" ") Senior women and Intermediate men
C 4½K (" ") Intermediate women and Junior men
D 2½K (" ") Junior Women, Boys, Girls & Novices
E 1½K: A pleasant stroll for anyone who wants it (Wives with kiddies etc)
* Courses A and B use Second set of Master Maps

FEES Seniors and Intermediates (aged 18 and above) 25p
Juniors, Boys and Girls (aged under 18) 12½p
Course E participants 12½p
N.B. Pairs/Family Groups pay (in accordance with BOF rules) one-and-a-half-times the normal entry fee for their class. If members of pairs/groups require a map each, they should enter individually but can be given the same Start time. (Groups of four or more persons will be discouraged from entering as such)
