CAR DIRECTIONS Pay and display parking is available adjacent to the assembly area in East Heath Road carpark (£3.50 per hour via RingGo). Free parking is available on nearby streets on Sundays.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT The nearest train station is Hampstead Heath which is on the Overground network. Belsize Park station on the Northern Line is the nearest Tube station and Hampstead Tube station is a similar distance. Buses 1, 24, 46 and C11 go to South End Green nearby.

COURSES All distances are indicative pending final planning and controlling.

Medals will be awarded to the first three SEOA members in each of the following age groups:

M/W 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20-40, 45-50, 55-60, 65-75, 80+

BOF members who have SEOA as their primary affiliation will be eligible to compete for medals in SEOA Championships. BOF members of CHIG, DFOK, GO, HH, LOK, MV, SAX, SLOW and SO will automatically be SEOA members. BOF members of HAVOC and SN have a choice of belonging to SEOA or EAOA/SCOA. Some members of armed forces clubs are SEOA members.

ENTRIES: Pre entry via [Fabian4](#). Seniors £11, Juniors (U21), Full-time Students and all participants on white and yellow courses £5.50, £2 supplement for non-members of British Orienteering. £2 late entry fee after 4th October and £4 very-late entry fee after 9th October. Late entries are subject to map availability. SI dibber hire £2 for contactless or £1 for non-contactless. (The replacement cost of hired SI Cards that are lost or not returned is £69 for SIACs (i.e. contactless) and £43 for standard SI cards.) Both SI electronic contactless and contact punching can be used.

LOK reserves the right to cancel or curtail this event whether for operational reasons, Force Majeure, or other reasons, in which case LOK reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees to recover event specific costs.

TERRAIN AND MAP Hampstead Heath is an ancient hilly heathland to the north of London. The area is a mixture of woodlands and open areas with an extensive path network and provides a good orienteering challenge. It includes one of the highest points in London. The Kenwood Estate is a former stately home on the northern boundary that is open to the public. Map scale is 1:7500 with a 5-metre contour interval. Pre-marked waterproof maps.



FACILITIES Toilets will be available near assembly. Tent for you to leave kit at your own risk. Cafés 350m away in South End Green.

TIMES Starts: 10.30 to 12.30. Choose your start time when you enter. The prizegiving will be at 13:30.

SAFETY Please take care to give the general public (dog walkers, families, etc) priority. Competitors are advised to bring their own water although we hope to have a water tap accessible..
